



This week, Governor Whitmer announced that **Michigan has officially reached the first of the four vaccination thresholds** established for easing restrictions within Michigan! The first of these thresholds, 55% of residents age 16 and older having received at least one dose of the vaccine, has been met.

What this means for Michigan employers:

- MDHHS (Michigan Department of Health and Human Services) will allow in-person work to resume for **all businesses** beginning **Monday, May 24**.
- Currently, employees are to be working remotely unless they are unable to perform their job away from the work site.
- Workplace safety guidance established by the MDHHS **has not changed** at this time.
 - Employers are still required to have written COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plans which include: daily employee health screenings, social distancing, and mask wearing.
- Although the CDC announced today that anyone who is vaccinated is able to go mask-less indoors, **local ordinances and guidelines for workplaces remain in place at this time.**
